Welcome kits for children

Majority of children placed in our home will be ages 13-17. Be creative, but a few recommendations are:

- Self-care items
- Devotional book/journal/pens
- Puzzles/games
- Fun snacks (no homemade items)
- Encouraging notes - lighthearted and fun
- Duffle bag/reusable bag for carrying belongings

Care kits for CPS staff

CPS staff have a difficult job and are stretched thin at this time. Encourage them while they stay in Buckner homes with the children with a care package:

- Self-care items
- Snacks (no homemade items)
- Fun office supplies
- Encouraging notes

Activity kits

Provide items that can be used by the group of children in the home.

These items can stay in the home for children to enjoy:

- Educational, hands-on activities (Science experiments, STEM kits)
- Group games
- Sports equipment
- Art supplies
